Shall the Board of Directors of the Hudson Community School District in the County of Black Hawk, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$11,650,000 to provide funds to construct and improve a safe and secure main entrance at Hudson High School; to renovate, remodel, repair, improve, furnish, and equip classrooms and support spaces at Hudson High School; to remodel, improve, and repair Hudson High School, including the HVAC system, lighting, flooring, and windows; and to construct, furnish, and equip a Career and Technical Education addition and a gym addition at Hudson High School and related remodeling?

**Full Text:**

Shall the Board of Directors of the Hudson Community School District, in the County of Black Hawk, State of Iowa, for the purpose of purchasing and improving grounds; constructing schoolhouses or buildings and opening roads to schoolhouses or buildings; purchasing of buildings, purchase, lease or lease-purchase of technology and equipment; paying debts contracted for the erection or construction of schoolhouses or buildings, not including interest on bonds; procuring or acquisition of libraries; repairing, remodeling, reconstructing, improving, or expanding the schoolhouses or buildings and additions to existing schoolhouses; expenditures for energy conservation; renting facilities under Iowa Code Chapter 28E; purchasing transportation equipment for transporting students; lease purchase option agreements for school buildings or equipment; purchasing equipment authorized by law; or for any purpose or purposes now or hereafter authorized by law, be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy annually, a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not to exceed One Dollar Thirty-Four Cents (\$1.34) per One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, or each year thereafter?
